



Birth certificates

If adopted, an adoption certificate

An affidavit signed by a solicitor stating no legal objection to the marriage

Always check the provider's upper and lower limits.

Check for hidden fees

To avoid any 'legal impediments', you'll usually need to supply the following:[4]

A good tour operator should ask you to supply your paperwork three months in advance, leaving plenty of time to process your wedding licence.


